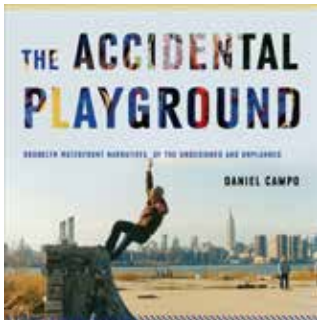

State Park in Williamsburg – others simply took to this decaying edge, transforming it into a unique venue for leisure, creative, and everyday practices. *Who decides?*
